• FORM OF THE LECTURE

The lecture cannot be longer than 10 pages. Payment for additional pages (maximum of 4) is 40 EUR per 2 pages.

Lecture summaries will be published in conference materials (ISBN). The qualified lectures will be printed in:

- Springer CCIS (ISBN) – Web of Science data base or
- “Archives of Transport System Telematics” (ISSN) after the conference.

Contents of the lectures will not be published without conference payment and lecture during the conference. Each author can submit maximum of two lectures. Surcharge for extra article is 90 EUR. The Organizers reserve the right to quality some of the lectures for the poster session. The sessions will be translated simultaneously into Polish and English.

Conference participants will be accommodated:

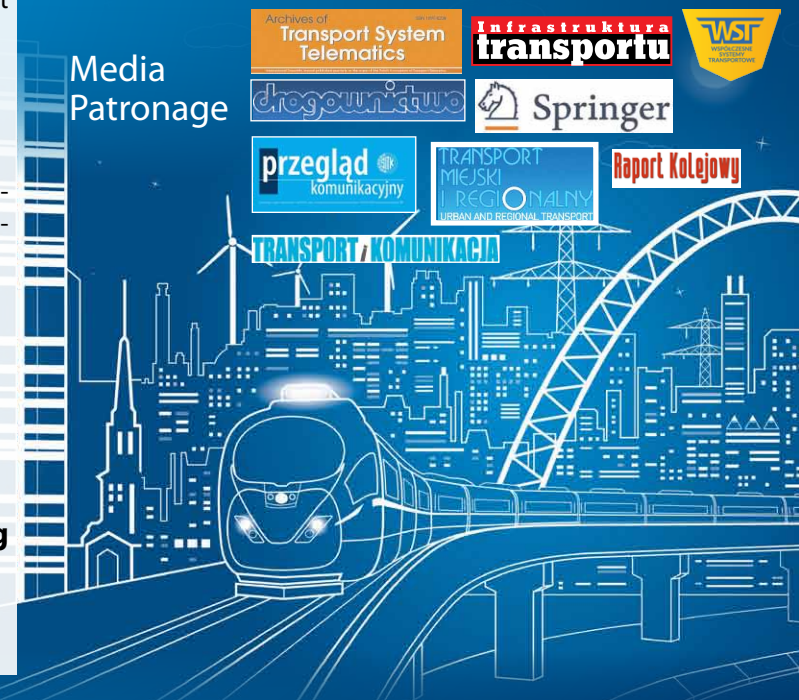
- at the hotel MUFLON (Sanatoryjna 32) or
