The world's first 3D virtual smart mobility congress "Green & Smart Recovery – Mobility 2.0" takes place on June 11th 2020.

Finnish mobility ecosystem joined forces to launch a green and smart mobility event to offer companies tools to reinvent their business to survive in the post-covid world and to explore the potential of smart mobility solutions in Green Recovery. The first-of-a-kind 3D congress, "Green & Smart Recovery – Mobility 2.0", will take place virtually on Thursday 11th June 2020 at 10:00-16:00 CET. The event will gather influencers, policy makers and industry representatives as keynote speakers and attendees across Europe and globally.
