### 4th European Conference on Connected and Automated Driving

The **European Commission**, together with the European Partnership on Connected, Cooperative and Automated Mobility (CCAM) and the **FAME** project<sup>1</sup>, are pleased to announce the 4<sup>th</sup> European Conference on Connected and Automated Driving (**EUCAD2023**), which will take place in Brussels on **3** and **4 May 2023**.
